REQUEST:

The City of Toronto (the City) received the following request under the *Act*:

Building permit, zoning examiners notes, related documents and plans/diagrams/specifications for any sign at:

The requester then listed a number of addresses.

The request also asked for affidavits in connection to a specific permit, the page that shows the description of the permit for all permits ever issued for a particular address, the 1998 agreement between the City and several sign companies concerning advertising signs along the Gardiner Expressway and Queen Elisabeth Way. Also included in the request were a number of other

types of documents including documents relating to a "mutually agreeable process" referred to in a contract, inspector notes and notices to property owners, investigations, communications between the City and named third parties, surveys, information concerning licensed sign painters and license applications and communications between two third parties.

DECISION:

The City informed the requester that it is of the view that this and other recent requests are frivolous and/or vexatious and provided an explanation for this opinion.

The requester (now the appellant) appealed the City's decision.


RESULTS OF MEDIATION:
